ABC TO MEET WITH SENATOR HAGAN ON EFCA

Charlotte, NC. – On Oct 13th, ABC leaders will travel to Washington D.C. to meet with NC Senator Kay Hagan on the Employee Free Choice Act (EFCA). Last week, ABC put out a call for letters to hand deliver to Hagan when a meeting was set. Now a meeting has been set for Oct 13th and ABC is doubling our efforts to get as many letters opposing EFCA to Senator Hagan over 2000 letters of opposition to EFCA.
